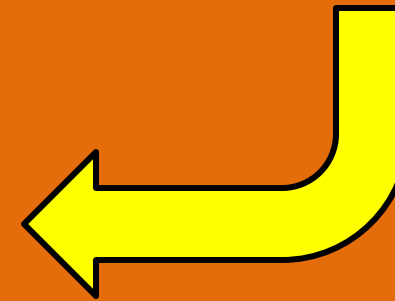
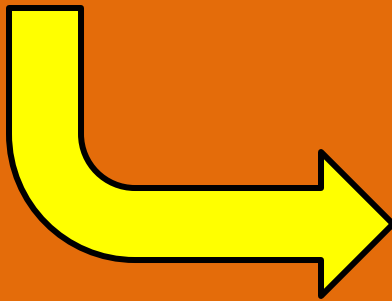

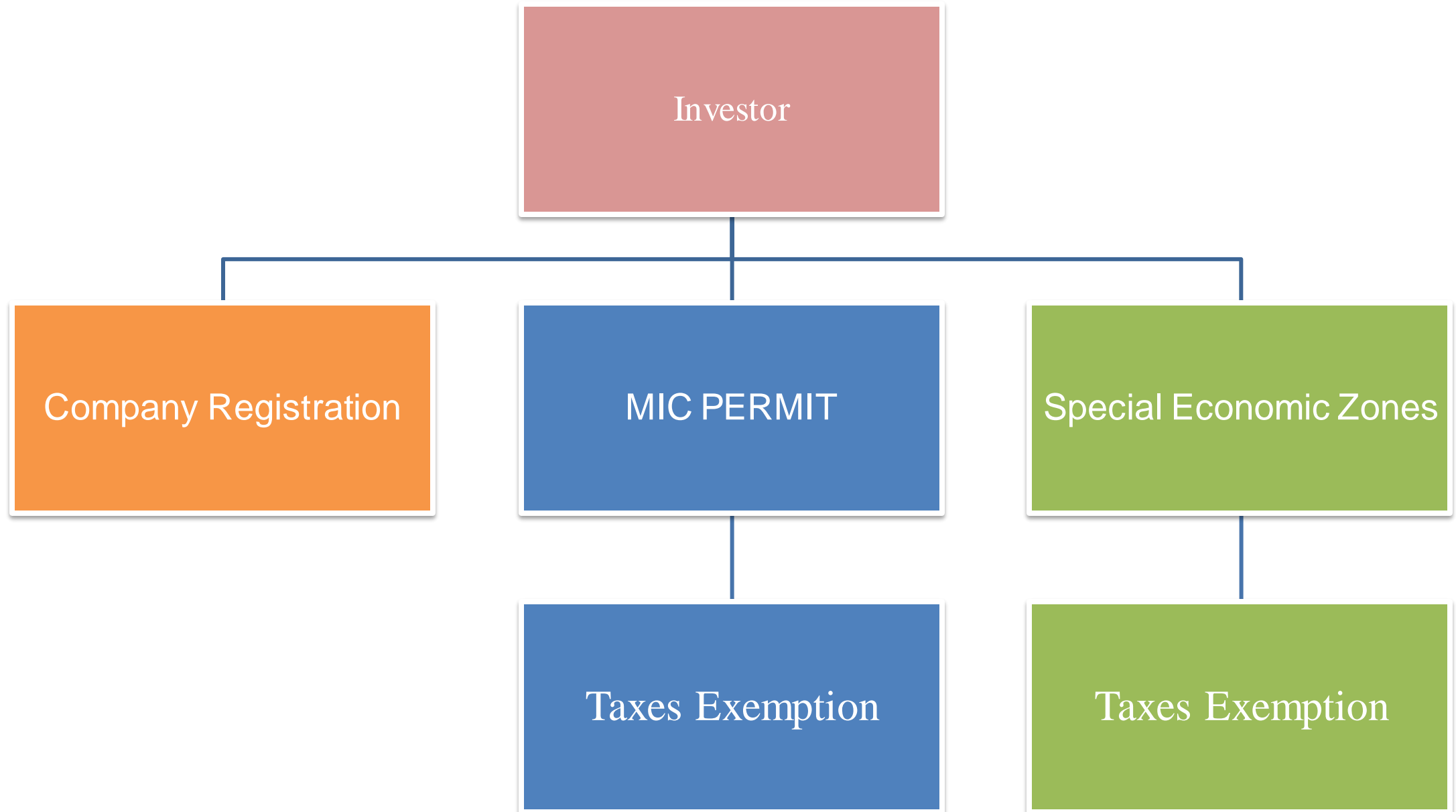

# 1. What is the poverty-environment-climate nexus issue in the management of investments in natural resources in your country?

- *Myanmar Mines Law 1994 was amended* on 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2015 with the advice of experts, publics and technical assistance of Aus AID, World Bank, the comments from the investors of Myanmar's Mining Industries and experts who have internationally experiences.
- In *new Mining Law* and Related regulation concern the environmental conservation, socio-economic of the locals and creating the Win-Win situation between the investors and the State.
- Also the *Myanmar Mines Rules is drafted* and almost finish to enacted within the 90 days after the approval for the Myanmar Mines Law from the Parliament. The drafted Myanmar Mines Rules will concern about management of investment including social-economic and environment,

  - *Lack of Hi-Technology*





